- Kriste Causey has had a big week. She completed antibiotics and had the PICC line removed, she is now off the oxygen therapy, and she finished her physical therapy. The PT nurse has said there is no need for rollator in the house unless she is alone, and to go without the rollator when walking the yard or short distances if she is with someone. She saw her Oncologist Dr. today and she says her numbers are doing great and to come back in two months. She will have an echocardiogram at the end of March, so please pray for that. She has also started coming down on pain medication and needs prayers there. She is looking forward to coming back to church as soon as she can.
- Ava West (5) - During the next phase of Ava's treatment, that she started on March 1, she will be taking several new medications that will "swipe" her remaining immune system completely, because of this she will not be having visitors, or going out, etc. She will continue PT, and this will limit her to only aquatic therapy. Ava has been experiencing severe neuropathy in her little legs & feet since the beginning of treatment. Over the past 2 weeks, her hands have been affected & she now struggles with small tasks like opening a drink, snacks, squeezing, etc.
